Indoor Recess Policy	<p>Physical Distancing</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Social distancing parameters ● When indoors, following same guidelines for in class learning ● Distance, masking, can't do the same activities as offered in the past, doesn't need to be school related, kids are bringing independent activities to do during those breaks, catching up on work so they don't have to do at home, reading books, art/crafts ● Deferring outdoor activities to another time
Character Trait Assembly	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● What is school doing about that? Used to be monthly assembly ● Mr Mann - not doing assemblies now, as we go through the year, possibly doing virtual through the

	school, many classrooms are trying to do that within their own classrooms
Bus Protocol	<p>Protocols</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Jeannine - parents gathered by the busses, no masks, no distancing ● Amanda - kindergarten teachers doing a great job but taking bussed children out at the same time as parents picking up walking children ● Darryl Mann - challenge at all schools to do arrival/departure in a same manner; not 100% safe so trying to mitigate risk as much as possible per the Health Unit <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Kids can't go onto bus until the end of the day, can't do staggered departures ○ Asking for social distancing, etc., but can't force people off school property ● Tara - can't force people on public property outside ● Mr Mann - can inform/educate but are limited otherwise
