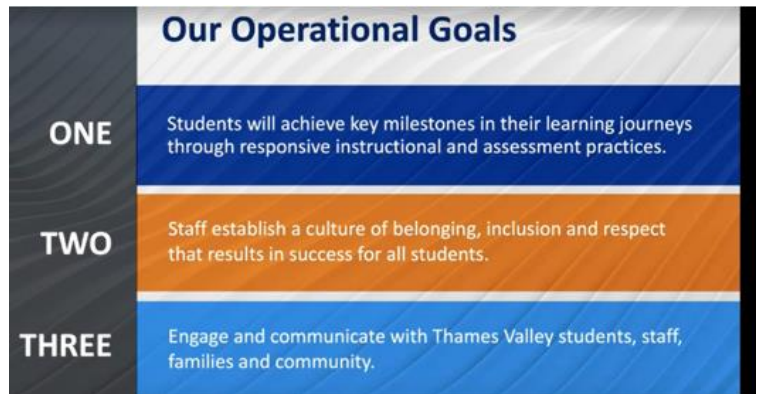
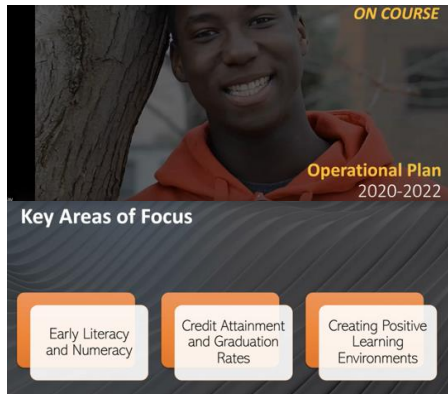

2. **TVPIC Parent Engagement Funds**

In alignment with Goal 3 of our TVDSB Operational Plan 2020-2022, Parent Involvement Funds (PIF) are available to support opportunities to engage parents/caregivers and families in support of student achievement and well-being. There are two funding opportunities to support these engagement opportunities: **Parent Involvement Funds (PIF)** and **Parent Engagement Funds (PEF)**.

- PIF - \$1000 (\$500 yearly + Carry-over, up to \$500 for one year).
- TVPIC has provided a list of suggestions for activities that may be of interest to school communities (attached).

3. **Every Student Belongs**

TVDSB is collecting information about the identities of our students. The survey is intended for parents and caregivers of students in Kindergarten to Grade 6. The survey asks questions about their children, including their grade, school, languages they speak, their ethnicity, race, religion, disability, gender identity, and parents education and employment. TVDSB seeks to understand how our students' identities and backgrounds can be met to ensure that all students are included and given the supports and opportunities they need to succeed.

4. **Safe Schools Update:**

- **Safe and Inclusive School Plan (SISP)** – The SISP brings together the Bullying Prevention and Intervention Plan (BPPIP) and the Safe and Accepting School Plan (SAP) documents that were previously used throughout TVDSB. The SIPS is facilitated at the school-level by a school-based team composed of students, family members, teachers, support staff, community partners, and the PVP.
- The **SISP** is fluid and responsive to our school needs. Based on our identified priorities, some initiatives may be adjusted throughout the year.
- There will be an **Action Plan** summarizing our priority areas that our team plans to address first. Following the development of our plan, we will share highlights of the plan with WNPS SAC and then with our community.

6. School Council Input: School Administration

School boards in Ontario are to solicit the views of School Councils with respect to the placement of Ps/VPs. This process is to occur annually. This process is to be discussed in March.
