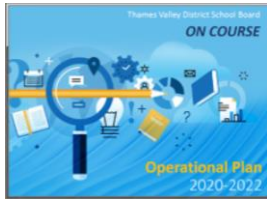

Update: Approved Volunteers in Schools

Subject to the approval of the School Principal, fully vaccinated volunteers may access the school with the following requirements:

- Visual confirmation of full vaccination prior to entry (record keeping of visual confirmation is encouraged)
- Sign In/ Sign out and Attestation procedures followed, as per the Approved Frequent Visitors & Essential/ Other Service Providers process.
- Contact tracing procedures in place (what classes/ students did the approved volunteer have close contact with? how long? when?)

This will be a school-based decision and may differ throughout the board.

Note:

- Fundraising efforts are to be undertaken outside of the school building, whenever possible.

6. Police Record Checks(PRC) and Offence Declarations

The school must have a Police Record Check on file. An Office Declaration is acceptable, if there is a Police Record Check on file at the school. However, the PRC on file at the school is critical.
